

WILL OF JOHN MOSS OF SWINESHEAD

John Moss made this will in 1820 but did not die until 1828. He was buried in Swineshead 21st July 1828 aged 80.

He must have been born in 1748 - give or take a couple of years for mistakes to be made as to his age at death.

His executors were **Henry Everard** of Crowland, grazier and **John Jackson** of Swineshead, grazier. Henry lived in Postland, Crowland.

John Jackson died in 1825 leaving **Henry Everard** as the only executor. They were left £500 each for their trouble.

People mentioned in the will:

John Chevin of Blankney, farmer, who received £150.

Richard Everard of Spalding, grocer who had £30.

Frances Everard, wife of Richard Everard who had £40.

Ann Hodgson, sister of Richard Everard who received £30.

John Moss's sisters:
